TICKET DETAILS

Tickets can be purchased online on May 10 for \$8 plus a processing fee. Starting May 26 tickets will increase to \$10 plus a processing fee. PLEASE DO NOT WAIT TO PURCHASE TICKETS

Everyone must have a ticket to enter the theatre, including young children who are capable of walking. Dancers get in for free and each dancer will receive 1 FREE tickets for each showcase and 1 FREE ticket for dress rehearsal.

A special code per family will be sent out via email that is redeemable starting May 10 to get your 1 free ticket per show. You MUST get the tickets through Dance Recital Ticketing to enter the auditorium.

A ticket is required for dress rehearsal. Each dancer will receive one free ticket for dress rehearsal for a parent to use. Dancers do not need a ticket for dress rehearsal. Any extra dress rehearsal tickets can be purchased on May 10 through Dance Recital Ticketing accessible through our website for \$5.

TICKET F&Q'S:

- Tickets are general admission
- Anyone can purchase tickets starting May 10 at 9am
- On Friday,, May 26 ticket prices will increase to \$10 + processing fee
- All parents/guests MUST have a ticket to enter.
- Dancers DO NOT need a ticket for entrance into the auditorium. Dancers only need a ticket if they will occupy a seat.
- There will be a small section of the theatre available for parents that are assisting their dancer backstage to watch "temporarily" to go back and forth backstage and to the theatre. This is a TEMPORARY seat and still will require a ticket.
- YOU MUST have your printed/electronic ticket from Dance Recital Ticketing on the day of the show.
- There are no refunds for tickets.

HOW TO PURCHASE:

- 1.You will receive a coupon code via email 5-7 days prior to ticket sales opening. The coupon code is sent from Dance Recital Ticketing to the main email address we have on file.
- 2.Print/Save your code coupon code. You will need it to purchase your tickets on May 10. Enter the coupon code when you check out. You will be able to get one FREE ticket per show.
- 3.Purchase your tickets and PRINT/DOWNLOAD your tickets. You will need to bring your printed tickets or show your electronic ticket at the door of the auditorium. You CANNOT get through these doors without a ticket.


Dress and technical rehearsals are an important part of preparing for our showcase. This is where we get to see the costumes working on stage in a group to really compliment the dances your children have been working so hard on throughout the year.

- 4:15 p.m. Doors open
- 5:00 p.m. Dress Rehearsal will begin
- 5:20 PM. **GROUP STUDIO PHOTO ON STAGE IN SHOWCASE T-SHIRT & BLACK LEGGINGS AT DRESS REHEARSAL. DON'T MISS IT!**
- Please arrive for your rehearsal times listed below
- Upon arrival, dancers can change in designated dressing rooms.
- Students are required to be in full makeup & hair, costume, tights, accessories and shoes for dress rehearsal.
- Parents of little ones are asked to stay and supervise their child while they are at the theatre.
- Food & Drink is not allowed in the Auditorium
- Dancers must have a guardian with them at all times
- Wait with your dancer in their dressing room and listen for your class name to be called to the staging area. At that time parent/guardian will go to the auditorium or wait in the dressing area for their dancer to be finished. This year we will NOT HAVE ANY PARENT VOLUNTEERS ON THE SIDE OF THE STAGE. WE WILL HAVE MC DANCE STAFF ASSIST.
- Check the dress rehearsal schedule to know block of time your dancer will perform in.
- Action Photos will be taken at dress rehearsal so Please be in make-up, hair, proper tights, shoes, etc.
- Once a dancer has finished rehearsal they can leave

Showcase Order of dances

SHOWCASE DAY

A large part of dance training includes learning through performance to build confidence and self-esteem. Our dancers work hard to prepare for this special day on stage. We create a professional recital with custom lights, special effects and videography. We ask that you do your part as a parent: be informed, prepared and most importantly - enjoy the show!

ARRIVAL

- At least 30 mins prior to showtime
- Have your tickets ready to be scanned upon entering the building.
- Find your assigned class dressing room & check-in with the staff
- Once your dancer is stage ready and the staff or Parent Volunteer is ready to take them, you may leave your dancer with the staff member and you can find your seat inside the theater.

DRESSING ROOM

- Staff will supervise and escort dancers to/from stage.
- Bring something for your dancer to do while waiting to perform (activities/games).
- LABEL ALL YOUR ITEMS *Bring a hanging bag or laundry basket with your dancer's name on it to put all items in.
- Males that need to change their dancer will have a private area. Please let Ms. Maggie know (info@mcdanceco.com) if you need arrangements.

QUICK CHANGES

If your dancer has any quick changes, please inform the Parent Volunteer and be prepared to meet them in the designated quick-change area to help between dances. *A quick change is considered 3 dances or less.

INTERMISSION

All dancers must remain in their dressing room or backstage during the intermission (unless finished with ALL dances) and will be allowed to visit family and friends before and after the show.

SHOW ETTIQUETTE

- Arrive early, as we start on time. Find your seat before the show begins.
- No videotaping or flash photography. This is a distraction to both the dancers and audience members. We will have action shots available for purchase after the showcase. In addition, you will receive a digital download of the showcase to share.
- Please remain seated during all performances and do not enter/exit during a performance.
- No food or drink is allowed inside the theater.

PERFORMANCE HAIR + MAKE-UP

We require both performance hair & makeup to create a polished stage look. Stage makeup ensures your dancer's facial features will not be washed out under the bright lights.

HAIR

Parted down the middle low bun

PRO TIPS:

- Use a lip stain to avoid red lips on costumes
- Use liquid eyeliner for best results
- Use false eyelashes for a more complete stage look
- Wet hair and use a gel to achieve a clean, slick look
- BOBBY PINS + HAIR NET (that match your dancers hair color)

MAKE-UP

- Neutral Smokey Eye
- Berry Red Lip
- Blush
- Eyeliner
- Mascara or Lashes

FINALE

If your dancer is in the Finale - YOU are responsible for escorting your dancer backstage 6 dances before the Finale to the Big Dressing Room. you must sign up for the finale and be at all rehearsals..

When the show is complete (after the finale) - Dancers will stay ON STAGE with their specific age group. Dancers 6 & under will have a designated assistant with them and are asked to stay together until being picked up by their parent.

Only dancers and ONE parent are allowed in the backstage/loading area. All other family members must remain in the theater or lobby area to visit and take photos

DANCER PICKUP

After your dancers performance - Pick your dancer up in the dressing room area and check them out with the Parent Volunteer. Please note, you are responsible for your child after they have completed EACH of their dances.

Parent volunteers are only responsible for getting them off stage and back into the dressing room where you will meet back up with them. Some PVs have multiple classes to attend to and cannot have children who are unattended lingering backstage dressing room..

COSTUME PHOTO WEEK

GETTING READY



Makeup should be applied the same as for showcase. Hair should be parted down center and smoothed into a low bun.



Shoes clean up nicely with a baby wipe. Please wait to put dance shoes on after you arrive! Our backdrop is white paper. Not only does walking in the parking lot tear up your shoes it also tracks in dirt. Tuck in ballet strings and tape them to the inside of their shoes.



Today is the day for new tights! Tights with holes and stains will show in pictures. Wear clean, new tights today and then save them for showcase!

ORDERING



Parents will receive an email to the email address on file the week before photos with information to order. You will have the option to:

1. Pre-pay for a package and receive special pricing
2. Purchase photos online after photo week when the photos are ready to view.

PICTURE DAY



Class Group Photos & Individual Photos will be taken during class in showcase costume



Dancers are only allowed in Studio 3 for photos. No Parents or Guardians please.



Arrive with your child in proper dress code for your first scheduled CLASS photo. If your child is in a COMBO CLASS they will take ballet photos first, followed by tap photos. Please do not let your children walk in the parking lot in their dance shoes. This not only damages the shoes but damaged shoes can damage the studio floors.



Studio 2 will serve as your dressing room for costume changes.



Please keep snacks in the lobby or outside. Additionally please only bring water as we would hate to have anything spill on your beautiful costumes.



When all your class photos are complete you are free to go!
